# \$353,730,000 State of Mississippi Tax-Exempt General Obligation Bonds Series 2011A

PURPOSE: The Series 2011A Bonds are to be issued for the purpose of providing funds (a) for the payment of the costs of construction, repair, renovation, replacement and improvement of buildings, facilities, exhibits and infrastructure at the Jackson Zoo in Jackson, Mississippi (the "Jackson Zoo Project"), (b) for the payment of the costs of construction, repair, renovation, replacement and improvements of buildings, facilities, exhibits and infrastructure at the Ohr-O'Keefe Museum of Art in Biloxi, Mississippi (the "Ohr-O'Keefe Museum of Art Project"), (c) funding for the repair, renovation, construction, furnishing and equipping of the facility for the Mississippi Children's Museum in Jackson, Mississippi (the "Children's Museum Project"), (d) matching funds for roads and parking at the Mississippi Craft Center in Ridgeland, Mississippi (the "Craft Center Project"), (e) for the payment of costs of projects related to the universities under the management and control of the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning ("IHL") for the purpose of paying the costs of capital improvements, renovation and/or repair of existing facilities, furnishings and/or equipping facilities for public facilities for the institutions or their successors (the "2004-2005 IHL and State Agencies Capital Improvements Projects"), including the design, construction, furnishing and equipping of a wellness center to be located at the R.W. Harrison Complex and repair and renovation of campus buildings, facilities, infrastructure and continuation/completion of the R.W. Harrison Complex located upon the campus of Mississippi Valley State University (the "R.W. Harrison Complex Project"), (f) to provide funds to pay the costs of site improvements, general weatherization, demolition and roofing, environmental, mechanical, electrical and structural repairs required for state-owned facilities, repair and renovation of state-owned facilities necessary for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, purchase and installation of necessary furniture and equipment, completion of previously authorized projects and payment of lease-purchase agreements (the "2010 Bureau of Building State-Owned Buildings Discretionary Project"), (g) to pay the costs of acquisition of real property, construction of new facilities, equipping and furnishing facilities, including furniture and technology equipment and infrastructure, and addition to or renovation of existing facilities for community and junior colleges as recommended by the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges (collectively, the "2010 Community and Junior Colleges Capital Improvements Project"), (h) for the payment of costs of capital improvements, renovation and/or repair of existing facilities, furnishings and/or equipping facilities for public facilities (collectively, the "2010 IHL and State Agencies Capital Improvements Project"), (i) for the payment of costs of capital improvements, renovation and/or repair of existing facilities, furnishings and/or equipping facilities for public facilities (collectively, the "2011 IHL and State Agencies Capital Improvements Project"), (j) to pay the costs of site improvements, general weatherization, demolition and roofing, environmental, mechanical, electrical and structural repairs required for state-owned facilities, repair and renovation of state-owned facilities necessary for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, purchase and installation of necessary furniture and equipment, completion of previously authorized projects and payment of lease-purchase agreements (the "2011 Bureau of Building State-Owned Buildings Discretionary Project"), (k) to pay the costs of site improvements, general weatherization, demolition and roofing, environmental, mechanical, electrical and structural repairs required for facilities at State institutions of higher learning, repair and renovation of facilities and State institutions of higher learning necessary for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, purchase and installation of necessary furniture and equipment, completion of

previously authorized projects and payment of lease-purchase agreements (the "2011 Bureau of Building IHL Discretionary Project"), (I) to pay the costs of improvements designed to conserve or assist in the conservation of energy at State-owned facilities and community and junior colleges (the "2011 Bureau of Building State-Owned Buildings Energy Discretionary Project"), (m) to pay the costs of acquisition of real property, construction of new facilities, equipping and furnishing facilities, including furniture and technology equipment and infrastructure, and addition to or renovation of existing facilities for community and junior colleges as recommended by the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges, (collectively, the "2011 Community and Junior Colleges Capital Improvements Project"), (n) to provide funds to pay the costs of repair and renovation of the Greenville Higher Education Center (the "Greenville Higher Education Project"), (o) to pay the costs of construction, furnishing and equipping of a new cabin/residential building, and other costs associated with the construction of a new cabin/residential building, and repair and renovation of the Mississippi FFA Center in Raymond, Mississippi (the "Mississippi FFA Center Project"), (p) to provide funds to pay the costs of construction, furnishing and equipping of the new Museum of Mississippi History building (the "Museum of Mississippi History Project"), (g) to pay the costs of (1) preplanning, to include contracting with consultants with expertise in planning a civil rights museum and in artifact acquisition, storage and relocating of artifacts; exhibit design through construction documents, exhibit fabrication and exhibit installation; and designing, preplanning the construction of, and the construction, furnishing and equipping of the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum on State-owned property adjacent to the new Museum of Mississippi History located in the City of Jackson, Mississippi (the "Civil Rights Museum Project") and (2) acquisition, and storage and relocating of artifacts, exhibit design through construction documents, exhibit fabrication and exhibit installation; and designing and preplanning the construction of, the new Museum of Mississippi History on State-owned property located in the City of Jackson, Mississippi; and the construction, furnishing and equipping of Phase I of such museum and designing and preplanning the construction of, and the construction of a parking garage and related facilities to serve the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum or the new Museum of Mississippi History (the "2011 Museum of Mississippi History Project"), (r) to provide funds for the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund created under Section 65-37-13 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended and/or supplemented from time to time, (the "Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Project"), (s) for the purpose of assisting counties and municipalities in the acquisition of fire trucks (the "Rural Fire Truck Program"), (t) to provide funds for the costs of capital improvements, renovation and/or repair of existing facilities, furnishings and/or equipping facilities for the facilities (the "Statewide Tourism Projects"), (u) for the repairs, upgrading, expansion, renovation or enhancement of existing buildings of facilities for the presentation, teaching for such buildings or facilities, and the costs of purchases of motion picture equipment for use in production activities (the "Arts Project"), (v) for the purposes of providing funds to purchase real property and to provide for the costs of administration and personnel expenses, necessary equipment and repairs, renovation and construction of facilities necessary for the improvement of the marine resources of the State (the "DMR Program"), (w) for the purpose of providing funds for the Mississippi Community Heritage Preservation Grant Fund to provide grants for historically appropriate restoration, repair and renovation of historically significant county courthouses (the "Community Heritage Preservation Grant Program"), (x) for the purposes of providing funds for the purposes of assisting counties and incorporated municipalities that own water systems, for assisting other water organizations that have been granted tax exempt status

under either federal or state law and for assisting other water organizations consistent with federal and state law and regulations (the "Local Governments and Rural Water Systems Program"), (y) to provide funds for the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund established pursuant to Section 49-17-85 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended and supplemented from time to time (the "2011 Water Pollution Control Project"), (z) to provide funds for one or more interest free nonrecourse loans to the City of Jackson, Mississippi, to assist in paying the costs associated with making repairs, upgrades and improvements to portions of the City of Jackson's water and sewer systems infrastructure located in areas within and in close proximity to the State grounds and lands described in Sections 29-5-2 and 29-5-81 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended and supplemented from time to time (the "City of Jackson Water and Sewer System Project"), (aa) to provide funds for the replacement or rehabilitation of the bridges on State maintained highways with a National Bridge Inspection Standards sufficiency rating of fifty (50) or less (the "State Highway Bridge Rehabilitation Projects"), (bb) to provide for the construction and reconstruction or improvement of those highway segments described in Section 65-3-97(4)(a) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended and/or supplemented, from time to time, and once those highway segments are complete, for the construction and reconstruction or improvement of those highway segments described in Section 65-3-97(5)(f)(xxvi), (xxvii), (xxxiv), (xxxv), (xl), (xli), (h)(xiv) and (xvi), (collectively, the "Vision 21 High Priority Projects"), (bb) to currently refund the State's General Obligation Note, Series 2011A, dated April 21, 2011, issued in the original principal amount of Nineteen Million Dollars (\$19,000,000) (the "Series 2011 Note Refunding Project" and together with the Jackson Zoo Project, Ohr-O'Keefe Museum of Art Project, Children's Museum Project, Craft Center Project, 2004-2005 IHL and State Agencies Capital Improvements Project, 2010 Bureau of Building State-Owned Buildings Discretionary Project, 2010 Community and Junior Colleges Capital Improvements Project, 2010 IHL and State Agencies Capital Improvements Project, 2011 IHL and State Agencies Capital Improvements Project, 2011 Bureau of Building State-Owned Buildings Discretionary Project, 2011 Bureau of Building IHL Discretionary Project, 2011 Bureau of Building State-Owned Buildings Energy Discretionary Project, 2011 Community and Junior Colleges Capital Improvements Project, the Greenville Higher Education Project, Mississippi FFA Center Project, Museum of Mississippi History Project, Civil Rights Museum Project, Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Project, Rural Fire Truck Program, Statewide Tourism Projects, Arts Project, DMR Program, Community Heritage Preservation Grant Program, Local Governments and Rural Water Systems Program, 2011 Water Pollution Control Project, City of Jackson Water and Sewer System Project, State Highway Bridge Rehabilitation Projects and Vision 21 High Priority Projects, (collectively, the "Series 2011A Projects") and (cc) paying the costs incident to the sale, issuance and delivery of the Series 2011A Bonds.
